

- 268.5 Merlot 'Nexus' 18.90  
*Meridiana, Malta*  
 Made exclusively from Merlot grapes, Nexus is characterised by soft, ripe cherry-plum flavours which are enhanced by careful maturation in barrique. The name Nexus celebrates the marriage between Malta's Old World geographical location and the New World vinicultural technology.
- 267.5 Antonin Noir 21.50  
*Marsovin, Malta*  
 Antonin is a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc grapes, all harvested from the Marnisi Estate in Marsaxlokk with Merlot being the dominant grape variety in the wine. Low yields, barrel ageing and judicious blending produce a concentrated, full-bodied wine.
- 301.5 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 8.50  
*Masciarelli, Abruzzo~Italy*  
 A clear wine which is deep ruby red in colour. The bouquet is intense, complex but very fine. The wine is full of flavours namely redberries, cherry, red currants, violets and hint of tobacco.
- 298.5 Valpolicella Classico Superiore 9.90  
*Domini Veneti, Veneto~Italy*  
 Corvina Veronese 65%, Corvinone 10%, Rondinella 20%, Molinara 5%. Well balanced, full-bodied and velvet smooth with the right tannin balance and acid strength.
- 302.5 Aglianico 10.50  
*Villa Matilde, Campania~Italy*  
 A wine which is brilliant ruby with purple hues, with a bouquet which is distinctive, elegant, intense and persistent. Reminiscent of spices, blackberries and ripe red fruit,. The palate is full, rich, velvety, with well balanced tannins.

- 135.5 Angimbe 9.50  
*Cusumano, Sicily~Italy*  
A wine marked by its scent ranging from the perfume of fresh flowers to that of ripe fruit, is born from the union of the Sicilian personality of Insolia grapes and the elegance of Chardonnay grapes. Glorious aromas of apricot, pineapple and peach mix with more perfumed notes.
- 488.5 Chablis 16.90  
*William Fevre, Burgundy~France*  
A fantastic representative of this great wine from one of the best producers of the area. A wine of intense steely character and prominent acidity.
- 489.5 Sancerre 'Grande Reserve' 16.90  
*Henri Bourgeois, Loire~France*  
A Sauvignon Blanc with a fine persistence and harmony that find their origin in the quality of the terroir and aging on the lees. This fruity wine with delicate and floral fragrances possesses excellent balance, invigorating freshness and delightful persistence.

- 490.5 Colline Teatine Rosato 7.50  
*Masciarelli, Abruzzo~Italy*  
Dark pink with bright glints with a fairly intense and fine aroma. It is fruity - flowery with hints of red cherry & rose petals

## Half Bottles Red Wines

- 491.5 Medina~Syrah 7.50  
*Delicata, Malta*  
The noble Syrah grape performs fantastically under the hot Maltese sun and produces red wines of great charm and finesse. An easy drinking, unoaked wine.
- 265.5 Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot 'Melqart' 16.50  
*Meridiana, Malta*  
Made from an artful blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grapes, Melqart is characterised by ripe berry flavours which are enhanced by careful maturation in barrique. The name Melqart recalls the Phoenician god of sailors worshipped in Malta during the Punic period.

- 483.5 Dolce Nero 49.90  
*Bufalefi, Sicily~Italy* 37.5cl  
 This Passito comes from 60 year old Nero d'Avola vines and is aged first for 12 months in barrique, then for another 6 months in a bottle. The colour is a beautiful ruby red with violet reflections and the aroma is a mix of wild berries, raspberries, cranberries and blackberries.

- 107.5 Chardonnay 'Isis' 13.50  
*Meridiana, Malta*  
 Made exclusively from Chardonnay grapes, Isis is characterised by fresh, natural, tropical fruit flavours. The name Isis recalls the Phoenician goddess of sailors whose vigilant eye still graces the prow of the Maltese fishing luzzu.
- 120.5 Gavi di Tassarolo 'Fornaci' 9.90  
*Castellari Bergaglio, Piedmont~Italy*  
 A stylish, graceful wine, far from commonplace. Floral nuances of hawthorn and lily complement fruitier notes of banana, followed by subtly pungent citrus, hay, and mint. Beautifully balanced on the palate, it concludes with a tasty, fruit-edged finish enlivened by a refreshing crispness.
- 123.5 Pinot Grigio 12.50  
*Santa Margherita, Trentino Alto Adige~Italy*  
 The clean, intense aroma and dry flavour with pleasant golden apple aftertaste make Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio a wine of great character and versatility.
- 129.5 Trebbiano d'Abruzzo 7.50  
*Masciarelli, Abruzzo~Italy*  
 A crisp wine with straw-like yellow colour and with greenish glints. It is fairly intense with a fine fragrance. On the nose hints of apple, apricot and iris are clearly distinct.
- 127.5 Soave Classico 8.90  
*Domini Veneti, Veneto~Italy*  
 Straw yellow in colour exuding crisp lemon character with a racy acidity and zingy aftertaste. Intense yet delicate aromas of white fruits and flowers. A dry, medium bodied and fresh flavour, with a touch of almonds, typical of the Garganega.
- 132.5 Falanghina 10.50  
*Villa Matilde, Campania~Italy*  
 A light straw yellow coloured wine with an elegant, fruity and floral bouquet. Distinct aromas of grapefruit and peaches, Genista and roses, as well as delicate notes of sage leaf. It is a pleasingly fresh and well balanced wine.

## Maltese White Wines

- 101 Caravaggio~Chardonnay 13.75  
*Marsovin, Malta*  
 This dry wine exhibits a bright lemon colour with refreshing aromas and flavours of a citrus fruit character of ripe lemons with delicate, floral, aromatic hints, and a crisp level of acidity.
- 102 Palatino~Viognier 'Limited Release' 13.75  
*Camilleri Winery, Malta*  
 This wine has light yellow colour, the nose is intense perfumed of flowers and ripe pear. The palate is round with fruit characteristics of apricot and mango which are supported by light to medium body and refreshing acidity.
- 103 The Maltese Falcon 14.25  
*Delicata, Malta*  
 An aromatic, fruity dry white wine made from an exclusive blend of Malta grown indigenous and international grape varieties. This full flavoured white has tropical flavours and a crisp refreshing finish.
- 104 Ulysses~Chenin Blanc, Chardonnay 14.75  
*Marsovin, Gozo*  
 Produced from grapes harvested in family owned vineyards, this medium bodied dry white wine has a pale lemon bright colour, aromas and flavours of a citrus and stone fruit character of lemons, limes and peaches. It has a refreshing acidity that is in balance with the fruit flavours.
- 105 Laurenti~Vermentino, Viognier 17.90  
*Camilleri Winery, Malta*  
 This locally-grown blend of unusual varieties shows a refined complexity that is immediately announced in its fleshy aromas of stone fruit together with candied lemon hints whilst lightly herbaceous. Its oaky character is further mingled into its full, juicy palate offering an unlikely combination of ripe softness and fruity power.
- 106 Gran Cavalier~Sauvignon Blanc 21.90  
*Delicata, Malta*  
 A tropical fruit flavoured, dry white wine produced entirely from Malta grown Sauvignon Blanc grape. The result is this full flavoured, rich, delicious Sauvignon Blanc.
- 107 Chardonnay 'Isis' 21.90  
*Meridiana, Malta*  
 Made exclusively from Chardonnay grapes, Isis is characterised by fresh, natural, tropical fruit flavours. The name Isis recalls the Phoenician goddess of sailors whose vigilant eye still graces the prow of the Maltese fishing 'Luzzu'.

- 108 Antonin Blanc 'Ramla Valley Vineyards' 27.90  
*Marsovin, Gozo*  
 Antonin Blanc is produced from selected Chardonnay grapes harvested from the Ramla Valley Estate in Gozo. Barrel Fermentation and ageing on the lees for up to 12 weeks in new oak barrels contributes an important aspect to the wine's essential character with aromas of vanilla and burnt toast giving way to crisp citrus and apple notes on the palate. It is full and round in the mouth and whilst retaining a fruity Chardonnay character, the subtle nuance of oak adds finesse and complexity.

## Italian White Wines

- 120 Gavi di Tassarolo 'Fornaci' 17.90  
*Castellari Bergaglio, Piedmont*  
 A stylish, graceful wine, far from commonplace. Floral nuances of hawthorn and lily complement fruitier notes of banana, followed by subtly pungent citrus, hay, and mint. Beautifully balanced on the palate, it concludes with a tasty, fruit-edged finish enlivened by a refreshing crispness.
- 121 Gavi di Gavi 17.90  
*Palladino, Piedmont*  
 Light straw yellow in colour with delicate and harmonious fresh fruit flavours. Flinty aromas of crushed stones and wildflowers. A lush mouth of gooseberries, zesty pineapple and crunchy green plums.
- 122 Langhe Arneis 20.90  
*Damilano, Piedmont*  
 A wine which reflects the harmony of the region. Made entirely from the Arneis grape variety. It is pale yellow in colour and is dry. The wine has an elegant, balanced and fresh flavour. A truly delicate and fruity wine.
- 123 Pinot Grigio 21.50  
*Santa Margherita, Trentino Alto Adige*  
 The clean, intense aroma and dry flavour with pleasant golden apple aftertaste make Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio a wine of great character and versatility.
- 124 Vernaccia di San Gimignano 15.90  
*Sensi, Tuscany*  
 Straw yellow colour wine with fruit aromas and flavours. A typical Vernaccia brimming full of character and a nice finish.
- 125 Isonzo del Friuli 'Pietraverde' 24.90  
*Cormons, Friuli Venezia Giulia*  
 This wine is a masterly blend, of Tocai Friulano, Malvasia Iriana and Chardonnay. The Tocai Friulano provides all the vigour of a dry and sharp flavour, the Malvasia Istriana enhances its perfumes whilst the Chardonnay gives the flavour its roundness, providing a fruity elegance.

## Sparkling Wines

- 470 Prosecco di Valdobbiadene 16.90  
*Val d'Oca, Veneto~Italy*  
 A sparkling wine with a clean nose, pleasantly fruity, with whiffs of apples and peach blossoms. Delicate and with a balanced taste, it is excellent as an aperitif, or for a celebratory drink.
- 471 Brut Rose' 'Mosaique' 48.90  
*Jacquart, Champagne~France*  
 Lively, fine perlage and bright pale yellow. Fruity nose reminiscent of apples and citrus fruit. Crisp, fragrant and refined palate with delicious hints of ripe apples and apricots.
- 472 Brut Imperiale 69.90  
*Moet et Chandon, Champagne~France*  
 Brut Impérial is a balance assemblage of the three grape varieties used in Champagne, disclosing a succession of elegant and harmonious sensations.
- 473 Dom Perignon 1996 210.00  
*Moet et Chandon, Champagne~France*  
 This is the prestigious cuvee of the Moet et Chandon house, name after the Benedictine monk who is attributed with the development of blending three grape varieties that give Champagne an added dimension of fruitiness, finesse and structure.
- 474 Cuvee Cristal 2002 360.00  
*Louis Roederer, Champagne~France*  
 Cristal is made according to the strictest criteria, based on a drastic process of selection applying to the vintage, the cru, the village, the grapes and finally the wines. Only Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes from the best sites are used in the production of this legendary cuvée.

## Dessert Wines

- 480.5 Moscato d'Asti 'Nivole' 14.50  
*Michele Chiarlo, Piedmont~Italy* **37.5cl**  
 An intense, aromatic and fruity wine, suggestive of sage and grapefruit. Clean, light and delicate, with balanced acidity.
- 481.5 Moscatel 'Goya' 14.50  
*Bodegas Camillo Castilla, Navarra~Spain* **37.5cl**  
 Intense, green-flecked golden yellow in hue, with pronouncedly floral aromas typical of the variety, together with a hint of syrup. Fresh and agreeably fruity on the palate, with overtones of white peach, it is surprisingly uncloying.
- 482.5 Passito di Pantelleria 'Mueggen' 38.90  
*Salvatore Murana, Sicily~Italy* **50cl**  
 Elegantly sweet, fresh and aromatic, with hints of honeyed dates. The vines are planted on terraces composed primarily of mineral rich crushed lava rock. A floral nose, yellow fruit and mineral finish 100% Moscato (Zibibbo).

## New Zealand Red Wines

- 440 Pinot Noir 49.90  
*Cloudy Bay, Marlborough*  
Intensely fragrant with alluring aromas of dark plums and lifted hints of blueberry, layered over spicy sandalwood and smoky bacon. The palate is succulent and flavour-some with dark fruits and toasty oak gently supported by plush tannins.
- 441 Tironui 30.00  
*Tironui, Hawkes Bay*  
Dark coloured. Quite a tight, intense dark fruits nose with some freshness and spicy, tarry notes in the background. There's a hint of minerality, too. The palate has wonderful acidity providing a savoury, tarry minerality to the dark fruits.

## North American Red Wines

- 450 Zinfandel 33.50  
*Edmeades, Mendocino County-California*  
Aromas of cherries, spices, roasted coffee and vanilla lead the way to the secondary aromas of earth and forest. Small amounts of Pinot Noir and Grenache add a perfumed fruit character to the aromas. Black fruit flavours show up on the palate followed by a long lingering finish.

## South African Red Wines

- 460 Pinotage 19.50  
*Simonsig, Stellenbosch*  
A youthful, un-wooded red wine with luscious ripe berry fruit aromas and flavours from mature bush vines.
- 461 Cape Fusion 19.90  
*Asara, Stellenbosch*  
Deep ruby black colour with rich plummy and black cherry aromas. Balanced with subtle cigar box and spicy mocha nuances. Filled with berry fruit that finishes with an elegant juicy structure.
- 462 The Very Sexy Shiraz 18.50  
*Cloof, Darling*  
Darling of origin, darling by nature. Grown in vineyards that have been described as "Shiraz Heaven", this wine's luscious fruit was accessorised with the very best French Oak, making a package that is so appealing and seductive that it could only be named after the experience one has when drinking it.

- 126 Traminer Aromatico 38.50  
*Jermann, Friuli Venezia Giulia*  
It has a rather intense and brilliant golden, straw-yellow colour. Its aroma is intense yet delicate, aromatic and fruity. Its taste is crisp, well-bodied, and balanced, with a slightly bitter aftertaste characteristic of this wine.
- 127 Soave Classico 16.50  
*Domini Veneti, Veneto*  
Garganega, Trebbiano. Straw yellow in colour exuding crisp lemon character with a racy acidity and zingy aftertaste. Intense yet delicate aromas of white fruits and flowers. A dry, medium bodied and fresh flavour, with a touch of almonds, typical of the Garganega.
- 128 Lugana 'Melibeo' 18.50  
*Santi, Veneto*  
A wine of appealing distinctiveness. Releasing crisp, fruity aromas that gradually expand to a rich complexity characteristic only of Lugana. The palate is rounded and generous, and has a wonderfully long, savoury finish.
- 129 Trebbiano d'Abruzzo 14.50  
*Masciarelli, Abruzzo*  
A crisp wine with straw-like yellow colour and with greenish glints. It is fairly intense with a fine fragrance. On the nose hints of apple, apricot and iris are clearly distinct.
- 130 Orvieto Classico 14.50  
*Barbi, Umbria*  
Made from Trebbiano and Malvasia grapes and named after the picturesque town of Orvieto, this wine is dry, quite full flavoured with a hint of almonds on the nose .
- 131 Frascati Superiore 'Vigneto Santa Teresa' 14.50  
*Fontana Candida, Latium*  
Pale gold colour; delicate but well-defined bouquet, with fine hints of sage and apple; full, soft but fresh and a lively and very savoury flavour with a definite, pleasantly lingering aftertaste of sweet almonds. A wine of great finesse.
- 132 Falanghina 16.50  
*Villa Maltilde, Campania*  
A light straw yellow coloured wine with an elegant, fruity and floral bouquet. Distinct aromas of grapefruit and peaches, and roses, as well as delicate notes of sage leaf. It is a pleasingly fresh and well balanced wine.
- 133 Greco di Tufo 22.50  
*Villa Matilde, Campania*  
With a straw yellow colour and a bouquet which is intense, persistent, appealing and complex, this wine is one of the best you can get of the sort. It is well integrated and structured, with distinct notes of white peach, apricot, sweet almonds and mineral nuances.

- 134 Chardonnay 14.90  
*Feudo Arancio, Sicily*  
 A harmonious, well-balanced flavour with fruity hints of red apple and nectarine and a delicate acidity.
- 135 Angimbe 17.30  
*Cusumano, Sicily*  
 A wine marked by its scent ranging from the perfume of fresh flowers to that of ripe fruit, is born from the union of the Sicilian personality of Insolia grapes and the elegance of Chardonnay grapes. Glorious aromas of apricot, pineapple and peach mix with more perfumed notes.
- 136 Insolia 'Lupara' 21.90  
*Az Agr. Bufalefi, Sicily*  
 A punchy, strong, zesty and very mineral wine. It is named after the white wolf and if you're on the lookout for a strong white, this is your bottle. Lupara has a very particular and beautiful green-gold colour and a fine and long-lasting finish.
- 137 Colomba Platino 'L' 16.75  
*Duca di Salaparuta, Sicily*  
 A fragrant and aromatic wine with an ability to bring the land of Sicily to expression due to an unyielding respect for tradition.
- 138 Vermentino di Gallura 'Monteoro' 18.50  
*Sella & Mosca, Sardinia*  
 A first perception of a delicate wine hide a strong character and complex structure in which flourish Mediterranean flora flavours.
- 138 Vermentino di Gallura 'Monteoro' 18.50  
*Sella & Mosca, Sardinia*  
 A first perception of a delicate wine hide a strong character and complex structure in which flourish Mediterranean flora flavours.

## French White Wines

- 150 Bordeaux Blanc 'Collection Privee' 18.90  
*Cordier, Bordeaux*  
 Sauvignon Blanc 90%, Semillon 10%. Nose is full of grapefruit aromas, alongside freshly cut grass notes. The palate is pungent and it finishes on the same clean notes of the nose.
- 151 Pouilly Fume' 30.00  
*Monmousseau, Loire*  
 The aromatic, floral and smoked nature of the Sauvignon grape variety is the most dominant aspect of this charming wine. It displays its elegance, fruitiness and roundness and is very persistent in the mouth.

- 392 Yellow Label~Merlot 20.75  
*Wolf Blass, South Australia*  
 This wine is a deep garnet in colour with light, purple hues. A soft palate of plum, cherry tones is balanced with a chocolaty oak. A full-bodied palate with exceptional depth of fruit and supporting oak in a soft, lingering finish.
- 393 Bush Vine Grenache 24.00  
*Yalumba, Barossa Valley*  
 Made from 70-year-old Grenache bush vines, this is Barossa Grenache at its best. Medium depth red in colour with hints of purples to the edge, the wine shows ripe stewed plum fruits with cloves, dense black fruits and hints of white pepper aromas. A full flavoursome palate, showing an excellent depth of sweet fruit flavours and fruit cake-like complexity creates a solid backbone of fruit persistence supported by spicy oak.

## Chilean Red Wines

- 400 Merlot 18.90  
*Casa Lapostolle, Rapel*  
 Deep red with purple shadows. Intense, ripe red fruit typical of Apalta. Plums & cherries integrate well with the delicate oak touches of sweet spice, nutmeg and vanilla. A generous attack is followed by a pleasant and smooth mid palate. The finish is persistent and the overall structure is vivacious and well balanced.
- 401 35 South~Shiraz 17.90  
*Vina San Pedro, Lontue Valley*  
 A silky, velvety wine with gentle tannins, fresh fruit and a finish that gleans hints of oak, revealing its complexity and complementing the initial fruit taste. This is a very friendly and attractive medium-bodied wine.
- 402 Carmenere, Cabernet Sauvignon 'Limited Selection' 18.50  
*Vina Montes, Colchagua*  
 With beautiful and intense ruby red colour. It has a very elegant aroma with notes of chocolate, coffee and also of vanilla and butterscotch. To the palate it is ample, full bodied, medium tannins with a persistent aftertaste.
- 403 Cuvee Carmenere 23.90  
*Missiones de Rengo, Rapel Valley*  
 Deep black plum. Aroma Intense and complex. Ripe fruit notes, blackberry jam, chocolate, vanilla and slight toasted hazelnut and cinnamon hues. Rounded taste, concentrated, slightly spiced, with black chocolate and cinnamon notes.
- 404 Marques de Casa Concha~Merlot 17.75  
*Concha y Toro, Rapel Valley*  
 A Merlot with great aromatic intensity, plum and blackberry jam mixed with spicy hints of vanilla and liquorice. A very attractive and elegant palate, enriched with toasted notes acquired through its oak ageing and a long aftertaste with lingering spices.

## Portuguese Red Wines

- 360 Crescendo 21.50  
*Altas Quintas, Duero*  
The wine shows a garnet colour and its aroma has strong hints of plum, some wild fruits and spices mixed with touches of the toasted wood in which it aged.

## Lebanese Red Wines

- 370 Les Breteches 18.50  
*Chateau Kefraya, Bekaa Valley*  
The first impression is vivid and fresh, balanced and structured. It mainly displays spiced and fruity notes sensed by the nose. The tannins are well present giving a structure to the wine. A wine which is very easy to taste revealing a certain complexity which is accessible to all.
- 371 Chateau Musar 42.75  
*Hochar, Bekaa Valley*  
Full and complex, fruit and earthy flavours are consistent with the nose, zingy acidity and soft tannins set up a very long finish with fruity and floral notes that seem to last for minutes. A very fine wine, capable of ageing for years.

## Argentinean Red Wines

- 380 Pinot Noir 'Saurus' 20.50  
*Schroeder Winery, Patagonia*  
Pleasant earthy character and depth of sweet fruit on the palate. It has spicy perfumes of cherry and summer fruits on the nose. It has concentration and power due to reduced yields and a warm summer. Lovely berry fruit and a touch of spice from the oak carry through to the finish.
- 381 Amado Sur 15.50  
*Bodegas Trivento, Mendoza*  
Intense ruby-garnet with purple rim. Ripe plums, cherries, brambles, vanilla and coffee abound on the nose with ripe, supple, soft tannins on the palate and juicy fruits with a good length. Made from a blend of Malbec, Bonarda and Shiraz.

## Australian Red Wines

- 390 Weighbridge~Shiraz 18.90  
*Peter Lehmann, Barossa Valley*  
Delightful fruit with a touch of wild spice and dark chocolate. A medium body wine showing good rounded berry fruit, with a soft long finish.
- 391 Parker Road Bin 8 26.90  
*Sir Paz, Yarra Valley*  
Handpicked as a vineyard selection of Shiraz and Merlot, fermented with indigenous yeasts and given a 6 week extended maceration, raked to older French hogsheads. Red cherry and white pepper nose, medium bodied savoury palate and a solid tannic backbone.

- 152 Sancerre 30.00  
*Monmousseau, Loire*  
Pale, whitish straw in color. The nose is very fresh, very clean with notes of lime peel, green herbs, black currant; typical, not aggressive. On the palate it is fresh and tightly wound; acidity is tempered by very subtle residual sugar; very clean; alive, racy, and youthful. Overall, a dry and elegant wine, well balanced.
- 153 Chablis 32.00  
*Jean Claude Fromont, Burgundy*  
This clean and fresh white has a bouquet of apple and citrus fruits and combines the appetizing minerality of Chablis with hints of richness beneath.
- 154 Pouilly-Fuisse 33.50  
*Antonin Rodet, Burgundy*  
Clear and shiny green-gold colour with silvery tints. Deeply packed with fruits and aromas of nuts, fresh almond and acacia flowers notes. On the palate soft and velvety with flavours of honey, brioche and white fruits.
- 155 Gewurztraminer 23.90  
*Domaine Klipfel, Alsace*  
Rich, spicy nose with lovely rose petal and litchi fruit flavours. A delicious semi-sweet wine with a crisp finish.
- 156 Riesling 32.90  
*Maison Trimbach, Alsace*  
This Riesling has an intense floral nose with hints of petrol and citrus. The palate is dry clean, with balanced acidity followed by a persistent after taste.

## Spanish White Wines

- 170 Viura, Malvasia 15.90  
*Bodegas Dinastia Vivanco, Rioja*  
This is a youthful wine that is clear and bright, with a pale lemon colour and slight green hints. Intense and elegant aromas of green apple, citrus fruits, pineapple and even some floral hints that round out the varietal expression.
- 171 Sauvignon Blanc 'Fransola' 24.75  
*Torres, Penedes*

*Bodegas Trivento, Mendoza*  
A wine with a bright golden yellow and a brilliant silvery edge. On the nose notes of chamomile, geranium, orange peel, peaches and honey. In the mouth chamomile and honey, peaches and ripe sweet lemons. Good balance of acidity and ripe fruits, appearing sweet, but with a clean dry finish.

All the exuberant aroma traditionally found in an intense, ripe red wine, with a sensual background of fine spices in good balance with perfumed notes reminiscent of blackberries. Full, long finish on the palate.

*Bodegas Navajas, Rioja*  
A wine with a deep ruby-red colour and aromas of dark berries and vanilla from the oak. It is also velvety-smooth and very elegant.
